Title IX Response at Indian Bible College

Indian Bible College takes sexual harassment and sexual violence very seriously. Here's what you can expect if students or employees experience any form of sexual harassment at IBC.

Initial Report

All community members are encouraged to report any potential policy violations directly to the Title IX Office. Person(s) affected have the right to choose to report and to whom. Reporting to IBC does not preclude you from reporting to law enforcement. Designated Reporters (all employees except those listed as Confidential Resources) are required to report.

Supportive Measures Meeting

The Title IX Office will meet with the person(s) affected to see how IBC can best support them and offer options toward a resolution. The person(s) affected have the ability to request interim protective measures and accommodations.





Complaint

To initiate the investigation process, a Complaint must be made either verbally (in-person, over the phone, or

Investigation All investigations will be fair and impartial without favoring one party over the other.



via video call) or in writing (inperson, by mail, or by e-mail)

Hearing

A decision maker within IBC will review the evidence and interact with parties to come to a final decision and outcome. All decisions can be appealed by either party.

Alternative Resolutions

In some cases, Supportive Measures are all that is needed to come to a resolution. When appropriate, a formal complaint may be resolved through a mediator based on agreed-upon outcomes.
